

This book deals mainly with the Dun family, tracing one branch for over one hundred years from just after the Napoleonic Wars up to the end of the Great War in 1918.

It describes the coming together of members of the Ward, Bedwell, Dun and Cork families in early Australia, and the consequent relationships which developed as the family expanded. In most cases, unfortunately, it was possible to mention the numerous family sub-branches only briefly.

The stories provide an insight into some of the adventures and difficulties faced by so many of our early migrants. It is hoped that their telling will bring those times to the attention of descendants and others so as to stimulate a desire to add to this history.
